#### EQUALITY

- The SU has run Gender Equality and 'Women in Leadership' campaigns. These issues are incredibly personal for me. I think future SU Gender Equality and Leadership campaigns should:
  - o Set clear goals

  - o Be run in partnership with staf
- o Leadership workshops should also be given for other groups who have been underrepresented in leadership in student organisations.

#### Improvement of Teaching Spaces

- –As college begins work on improving classrooms and teaching spaces, I would ensure that students have input
  - Alternative Study Spaces

- Student Centre should contain a proper study space that caters to many different kinds of learners

#### REPRESENTATION AND ACCOUNTABILITY

The Students' Union could do more to represent its members well. If elected, I will...

- <u>Hold Skype Office Hours</u> representing and taking care of students should not stop at Front Gate. This would allow students who are not on the Trinity campus, or cannot access the offices in House 6, to engage with the sabbatical officers especially Welfare and Education
- Improve Council The Chair of council needs to be empowered to enforce new rules, such as limits on speaking time and ensuring debate is productive.
- Make Sabbatical Elections more accessible A position on the sabbatical officer team should be open to anyone, not just those in the know!
- o Past manifestos and information should be available on the website until the opening of nominations

### **ERASMUS AND STUDY ABROAD**

- Create Study Abroad reps so that students who are studying abroad can be represented by a Trinity student studying at the same college as them.
