

CAMPAIGNS

We have to unite and work to be heard. I'll lead the fight on the core issues affecting students, and support everyone with the tools to take a stand on issues important to them.

HIGHER EDUCATION

I oppose fee increases, and any cuts to grants: college has to be accessible. We should be fighting for an increase to the National Training Fund, to shift the burden away from students and on to employers.

The implications of Repeal affect our students. The SU is mandated to support Repeal and I'd robustly apply that mandate, having the Union take its place in the national conversation. Equally, I'd support debate and openness within Trinity - the SU represents all opinions.

EMPOWERING PEOPLE

INCLUSIVITY TRAINING

I'll work to make sure clubs and societies learn how to be inclusive by developing an inclusivity training programme. Events should be welcoming to everyone.

THE PART-TIME OFFICERS

We need to reform the part-time officer system to make the SU more accountable and accessible. The officers should all hold office hours, and be trained in campaign strategy to support students who want to make change.

Our first college week next year will be an empowerment celebration. We need to build a culture of giving everyone the opportunity to be heard and contribute to college life, however they choose.
