Ag fás aníos sa Ghaeltacht, bhí go leor deiseanna agam mo chuid Gaelainn a úsáid, agus nuais a thosnaíos sa choláiste thapaidh mé aon deis go rabhas in ann mo chuid Gaelainne a úsáid.

Tá liosta thíos de mo taithí

- Bheith ar an nuacht agus ag labhairt ar Radió na Gaeltachta ar son mo bhunscoil agus mo mheánscoil.
- Dheineas cúrsa ceannaireachta san idirbhliain, a chuir ar mo chumas a bheith i mo cheannaire sa chlub óige áitiúl agus cabhrú le gníomhaíochtaí a eagrú do chlubanna óige.
- Dheineas taithí oibre le Ros na Rún ar feadh seachtaine agus bhíos mar duine breise i dhá mír san idirbhliain.
- Tá mo shamhraidh caite agam ag obair mar cheannaire ar chúrsaí gaeilge le Coláistí Chorca Dhuibhne. Mhúin sé an oiread sin dom faoi bheith ag obair le mic léinn agus ag léiriú a gcuid riachtanas Gaelainne.

- Dheineas físeán do 'Amhrán na nGael' a dhein coiste na Chuallachta a thaifead.
- Freastalíos ar 'Traenáil na gCumann' a d'eagraigh Conradh na Gaeilge ag túis na bliain acadíúil 2022/2023.

Experience

Growing up in the Gaeltacht, I had a lot of opportunities to utilise my Irish, and when I started in UCC, I took every opportunity I got to use my Irish.

I have compiled a list below of my experience:

- Appearing on the news and speaking on **Rádió na Gaeltachta** on behalf of my primary and secondary school.
- Completed a leadership course in transition year, that enabled me to become a leader at youth club and help with organising activities for youth clubs.
- In transition year, I spent a week doing work experience with **Ros na Rún**, and even appeared in the show for two episodes as an extra.
- I have spent my summers working as a Ceannaire on Irish courses with **Coláistí Chorca Dhuibhne**. It has taught me so much about working with students and representing their Irish language needs.
- Since starting college in UCC, I have had an eagerness to be involved with student life such as societies. I have been involved with the committees for the Irish societies, **An Chuallacht Gaelach**, for the past year, and **An Cumann Drámaíochta** for the last 2 years. I was acting in a display we done of '**An Trial**'.
- I partook in **Gníomhaí Gaeilge** with **Conradh na Gaeilge** for the past year.
- In second year, I served as an academic rep for my Irish course. I thoroughly enjoyed it and found it rewarding representing my class and helping students in my class out with any issues they had. It led me to want to do more to represent and engage with students, so I ran for College of Arts, Celtic Studies and Social Sciences (CACSSS) College Rep and have been in the role for the past year on the Students' Union Executive in UCC. I have been proudly serving CACSSS students and working with them on their issues and needs.
- Throughout that role, I helped co-ordinate the National Student Walkout in UCC on the 13th of October organised by USI. I was speaking on **Nuacht TG4** on behalf of UCCSU.
- I have been living in '**Áras Úí Thuama**' the Irish Language accommodation in UCC for the past three years.
- Partook in '**Scéim na Scoil**' with **Ionad na Gaeilge Labhartha** this year.
- Wrote an article for '**Iris Breac**' this year.
- Helped organise for a group from UCC to attend **Oireachtas na Samhna**
- Filmed '**Amhrán na nGael**' which members of **An Chuallacht** recorded
- Attended '**Traenáil na gCumann**' organised by **Conradh na Gaeilge** at the start of the academic year.

I have loved working with students and would like to continue to advocate on their behalf for their needs. All of my experience has taught me how to engage with students and the necessary skills for the role of **Leas Uachtarán don Ghaeilge**.
